Dance Masters of America (DMA) is a Non-Profit Educational Organization of dance educators, who have been certified by test to teach; have had a professional dance career; have a degreed certification from an approved institution of higher education; or have successfully passed an exam in an approved professional dance organization.

The Mission of DMA

The Dance Masters of America is a professional, certified membership organization of artists and educators committed to the elevation of the art of dance and to provide innovative artistic experiences for the advancement of dance worldwide.

The Objectives of DMA

- enable dance educators and their students to meet for a cooperative and collective study of their profession;
- advance the art of dance and improve the practices of its teachings;
- strive for the mutual interest and fraternal cooperation of its members;
- aid young dancers and dance teachers by awarding educational dance scholarships to accredited colleges, private schools of dance, educational and/or DMA educational workshops or conventions.

DMA has been certifying and setting the standards of dance education since 1884. Since its inception, the goal of the organization has been to improve the standards of dance offered to its members and their students.

Texas Dance Masters (TXDM) was chartered in February 2024 and is made up of chapters in Texas, Louisiana, and Oklahoma. Its membership consists of teachers certified by test, degreed teachers, and dance professionals. Members are active teachers in their respective communities and are required to complete continuing education training each year to ensure they are current with ever emerging teaching techniques and skills.

TXDM hosts a 3-day convention each November offering scholarship auditions on one day and two full days of classes taught by well-respected instructors and industry professionals. Students enjoy instruction in Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Modern, Hip Hop, Modern, Lyrical, Ballroom and more. On Saturday night, students and their families gather for the scholarships awards and recipients are presented with a certificate and a cash award. There are special guest performers and, of course, a dance party! It is the goal of TXDM to not only inspire dancers to realize their potential, but also to build a community and establish friendships that go far beyond the dance room.

Each spring, TXDM hosts a Title Pageant Competition where winners of four different age groups are crowned and earn an entry to DMA Nationals to compete for a national title. Dancers are scored in an audition setting in Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Modern, Acro, and personal interview and perform a solo in front of a live audience. There is also a Performing Arts Competition open to soloists, duos, trios, and groups. Winners are awarded crowns and sashes, medals and trophies and the opportunity to represent the chapter throughout the country as guest performers. Title holders compete at DMA Nationals and enjoy classes with nationally acclaimed teachers, choreographers, and active professionals.

TXDM is proud to have the reigning 2025 Master Dance of America, Shepherd Parr, the 2025 1st Runner Up Petite Miss Dance of America and winner of Outstanding Jazz Award, Ally Poole, and 2025 Top Ten National Finalist Junior Miss Dance of America, Alyvia Adamson.

TXDM also extends membership to students aged 13-18 as Junior Members. Through this opportunity, students learn how the organization operates and serve as mentors to the younger students. They assist faculty at convention weekend, assist with ticket and program sales at Title Competition and enjoy informational talks with industry professionals and private classes with faculty at convention weekend. They perform twice a year at the convention floorshow and at Title Competition. These members are encouraged to continue their dance education and become a full member of TXDM and Dance Masters of America no matter where their post-high school journey takes them.

Annual dues are \$90.00 and include membership in DMA National. Members are required to attend Fall Convention and Title Competition to ensure we provide a well-organized event for our students and their families.
